Election years energize young people ready to lead in politics

Throughout 2024, Christian students watched the left campaign for policies and leaders deeply antagonistic to their conservative principles.

Many of those students sought out ways to engage in politics and to stand up for truth against the left's radical ideology.

In 2024, because of you, the Christian Leaders Program:

- > Recruited more students than ever.
- ➤ Innovated to give students more and better training opportunities.
- Swelled the ranks of young Christian leaders ready to serve America and defend her founding principles.

Your support brought back high-impact events in the program, including training and scholarships to attend the National March for Life and the capstone of the program, LI's Christian Statesman Conference.


You also made possible new opportunities for students.

The Christian Leaders Program started 2024 strong, when your Leadership Institute sponsored 105 Christian students to attend the National March for Life in Washington, D.C.

Prior to the March, students attended a special training at Leadership Institute headquarters in Arlington, Virginia. Here, LI staff taught them how to make compelling signs for the rally and how to conduct successful pro-life activism on campus.

Thanks to you, students returned to campus with the motivation and know-how to defend their pro-life principles.





New Opportunities Create Stronger Christian Leaders

In 2024, your Leadership Institute developed a new training program: **Christian Leaders Workshops**.

These three-hour training sessions teach students how to advocate for conservative principles on and off campus.

Your Leadership Institute tailors these workshops to the activism and career goals of the students who request training.

Working with the staff of LI's Christian Leaders Program, students select one of several possible tracks to focus their three hours of study:

- Coalition Building
- > Recruitment
- ➤ Media and Communications
- > Pro-life Activism
- Applying Conservative Principles in the Political World
- Networking and Engagement

Leadership Institute staff work with conservative student groups to bring these workshops to campuses nationwide. In 2024, your Leadership Institute conducted Christian Leaders Workshops for students in campus chapters of Young Americans for Freedom, Students for Life, Christians United for Israel, and Network of Enlightened Women, among other groups.

Thanks to your support in 2024, your Leadership Institute trained 204 Christian leaders in 18 Christian Leaders Workshops.



2024 Christian Statesman Conference

IRON SHARPENS IRON

The capstone event of LI's Christian Leaders Program is the Christian Statesman Conference.

Thanks to your support, the Leadership Institute brought 44 students from 30 different colleges and universities together for the three-day conference.

Held at Leadership Institute headquarters in Arlington, Virginia, from May 30 to June 2, 2024, the conference developed students in three key areas:


- Practical skills for political activism and personal leadership.
- Connections with like-minded peers and professionals in the conservative movement.
- ➤ Understanding of the tradition of Christian statesmanship in America and their place within that tradition.

Through hands-on training, students learned skills for public speaking and then practiced those skills on camera in the Leadership Institute's on-site television studio. They also learned how to organize and lead their peers on campus and how to launch their own conservative organizations.

One great benefit of the Christian Statesman Conference is in the connections students form with each other and with Christian professionals. At the conference, students network with Christian professionals who work in academia, think tanks, journalism, and public policy to learn about job opportunities and exciting career paths within the conservative movement.

Throughout the three-day program, the conference immersed students in the tradition of Christian statesmanship in America and the biblical heritage at the heart of American history and public life.

Students prized this special opportunity. Ony Otiocha, a student at North Carolina State University, said, "I was able to learn how I can integrate Christianity into the political world without compromising my integrity. This conference has been an amazing experience."





Students toured the United States Capitol and national monuments, where they discussed the important role of biblical and conservative principles in the American system of government.

Another student, Margaret Taylor from St. Louis University, said, "I will bring the information I learned this weekend back to campus and spread conservative principles."

Your support transformed these young men and women into a new generation of conservative leaders who will take up the mantle of Christian statesmanship and continue the fight for America's founding principles.

Christian and Conservative Conferences Provide More Unique Experiences and Networking Opportunities

The Leadership Institute's Christian Statesman Conference highlights the value of bringing principled, motivated young leaders together.

That's why your Leadership Institute also sponsors students in the Christian Leaders Program to attend other top Christian and conservative conferences.

Leadership Institute staff also attend those conferences to recruit students into the Christian Leaders Program and expand the reach of Leadership Institute resources available to students.

Students in the Christian Leaders Program who attended the Leadership Institute's training for the National March for Life in January received scholarships to attend Students for Life's National Pro-Life Summit the day after the March for Life.

In June, your Leadership Institute sponsored 15 students to attend the Faith and Freedom Coalition's annual Road to Majority

Conference in Washington, D.C. There, students saw firsthand what fighting for conservative principles looks like in practice.

Thanks to your support, the Leadership Institute sponsored students to attend one particularly special conference in September 2024 — Counteract USA's Resolve to Stand Conference held in Rogers, Arkansas.

As you will read later in this report, an alumna of LI's Christian Leaders Program founded Counteract USA. Your Leadership Institute proudly sent students to Resolve to Stand to see for themselves the growing

leadership in which they follow.

Christian Leaders Whose Lives You Change

Jessica Miller Takes Her First Steps in a Promising Career in Journalism

When Jessica Miller started at California State University — Chico, she expected to find a community with a vibrant exchange of ideas.

Instead, she found a leftist propaganda machine that did not welcome her conservative principles.

On her first day of class, she spoke out in defense of a conservative politician whom her peers relentlessly criticized. Singled out as a conservative, this made her "the number one target for studentprofessor debate in our classroom," as Jessica put it.

Jessica found herself in the proverbial lion's den, but she refused to back down or hide her beliefs. She turned to your Leadership Institute to learn the skills to defend her conservative principles in front of her leftist peers and professors.

An aspiring journalist, Jessica attended your Leadership Institute's 2024 Christian Statesman Conference to network with conservatives working in the media.

At the conference, Leadership Institute staff connected Jessica with LI's Campus Reform news organization and with the *California Globe*, a conservative online newspaper in the Golden State.

Just two days after the conference, the *California Globe* published an article Jessica wrote about the threats to freedom of expression in the California State University system.



Because of your support, Jessica took her first steps in what may become a powerful career as a conservative journalist.

Jessica also joined LI's Campus Reform as a correspondent and now receives ongoing mentorship to help her succeed in journalism after college.

Jessica is grateful for these opportunities. She said, "I am so thankful that I can use my voice to stand up for my faith in politics."

Your support gave Jessica the knowhow and resources to defend conservative principles, even in the face of strong leftist intimidation and fierce opposition.

Abigail DeJarnatt and Allie Paris Inspire Their Generation to Fight for the Truth

Growing up, Arkansas natives Abigail DeJarnatt and Allie Paris both felt called to take a stand for Christian principles in a secular world.

Abigail followed her calling in 2021 and formed the Christian nonprofit organization Counteract USA. She later recruited Allie to serve as the organization's chief operating officer and director of development.

Counteract USA trains young Christians to apply biblical principles to today's cultural and political questions, rooting the answers to those questions in eternal truths.

Looking for guidance on running Counteract USA, Abigail and Allie joined your Leadership Institute's Christian

Leaders Program. They attended the Christian Leaders Program's National March for Life event in 2023 and both Christian Statesman Conferences that year. These training programs taught them fundamental skills for organizing, growing, and leading Counteract USA.

Abigail and Allie also connected with other young conservative Christian leaders, several of whom now work with Counteract USA. Through Counteract USA, Abigail and Allie pass on many of the insights they learned from your Leadership Institute.

Abigail and Allie also use the skills they learned in LI's Christian Leaders Program to host Counteract USA's Resolve to Stand National Conference. Resolve to Stand inspires students to stand up and fight for the truth on their campuses and for a lifetime. In 2024, more than 500 people attended the Resolve to Stand National Conference.

In 2024, Abigail and Allie achieved another victory for their conservative principles by leading the Decline to Sign campaign against a radical pro-abortion ballot measure in Arkansas. Abigail and Allie organized students in Arkansas and taught them the powerful activism skills they had learned from your Leadership Institute. Their hard work paid off, and the abortion measure was not on the ballot in Arkansas in the November elections.

You gave Abigail and Allie the tools to transform Counteract USA into a professional and successful conservative

organization — and they're deeply grateful.
